Food and Drink

Blend at Contemporary is our in-house cafe, which will be open throughout the Symposium.

You can find Blend at Contemporary on the bottom floor of our building - accessible by stairs or lift.

Our cafe can get busy during events and weekends, and we anticipate it may be so during the Symposium lunch break.

Relaxed cafe and coffee roastery, serving locally-sourced produce and a large lunch and breakfast menu. Take-away options are also available.

Award-winning Nottingham deli, cafe, and wine bar, serving breakfast, lunch, and speciality hot drinks. Outdoor seating and take-away options available.

Independent coffee shop and coffee roasters, serving sandwiches, salads and soups as well as cakes and pastries.

The Hockley & Lace Market area of the City has lots of cafés, restaurants, bars, and pubs, and is just a few minutes' walk away from the gallery. Head towards Carlton Street / Goosegate.

Hockley Arts Club: Large creative space for social eating and drinking, open late for cocktails and dancing at weekends.

Getting Here

Nottingham Contemporary's large green and gold coloured building sits on the corner of Week-day Cross in the Lace Market area of Nottingham city. Our postcode is NG1 2GB. The nearest tram stop is Lace Market and we are a few minutes on foot from Fletcher Gate which serves several bus routes around the city and county.

Nottingham Train Station is 0.3 miles away / approximately 7 minutes on foot.

We have an accessible building with lift access on all floors. We have two toilets for functional diversity on the lowest floor, including a gender neutral and Changing Places toilet.

Portable fold-up stools are available for you to take around our galleries. We can also provide a wheelchair for you to borrow. Please ask at reception for more details.

Large-print versions of exhibition information panels are available in the galleries and we can provide other information in large print on request. We welcome guide- and hearing-dogs throughout the building.

Hearing loops are available at reception and in our auditorium. Please contact a member of staff for further information.

Our lockers are able to store most large bags or buggies.
