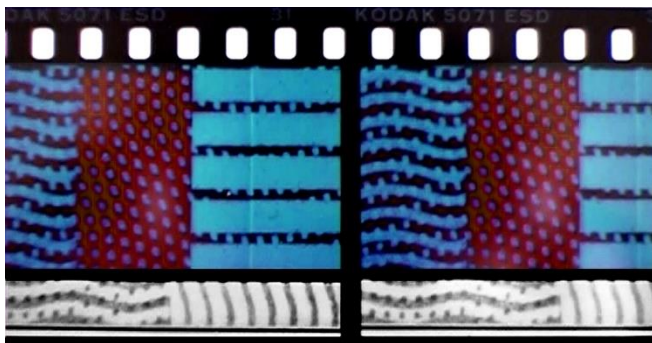
Our activities are inspired by our exhibition,

Sat 25 May – Sun 1 Sept

#### Colours of Noise

Make noise machines to compose a colourful soundscape. Use our recording booth to turn your small sounds into big noise.
