New Year's Eve 2020 Families Par'tay Arm Streamers by Ursula Rae

Materials required from your packs

- 1) A4 sheets of coloured paper
- 2) Tissue paper/Crepe paper sheets
- 3) Stickers to use as tape

From home

- 1) Scissors
- 2) Tape

Instructions

- 1) Cut strips across the width of the paper.



- 2) Check that the paper strip fits around your wrist.



- 3) Double over the tissue paper, to make cutting quicker.

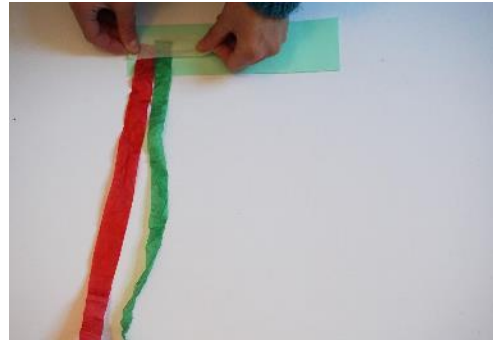


- 4) Cut strips of tissue or crepe paper, you can cut a range of sizes, wide and narrow.

- 5) You might want a mixture of colours!

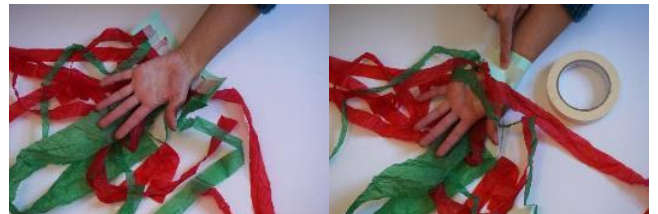


- 6) Lay your strips of tissue paper onto your wrist strap, and tape/stickers into place.



- 7) Lay your hand onto the wrist strap with the taped/stickered pieces on the inside.

- 8) Wrap paper strip around wrist and tape/stickers in place



Tah-dah!

- 9) You are now ready to dance! Hear those streamers whoooosh through the air as you move to the music.

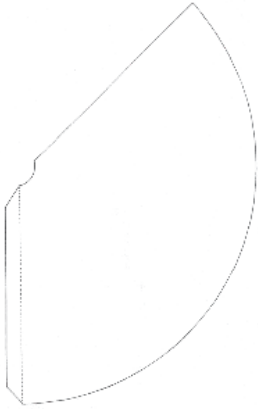


New Year's Eve 2020 Families Par'tay

Materials required from your packs

- 1) Card template



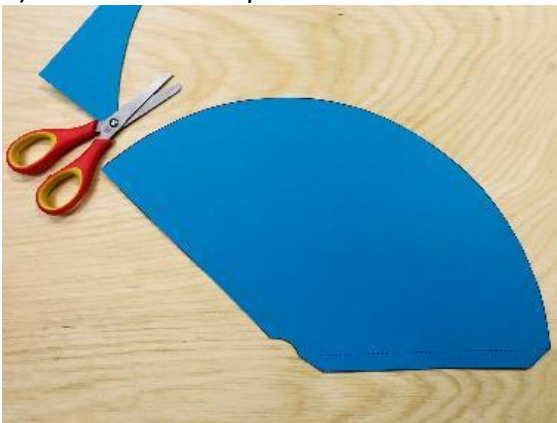
- 2) Length of elastic
- 3) Card, stickers and shapes to decorate

From home

- 1) Scissors
- 2) Tape
- 3) Felt tips
- 4) Hole puncher (if you have one)
- 5) Glue stick (if you have one)

Instructions

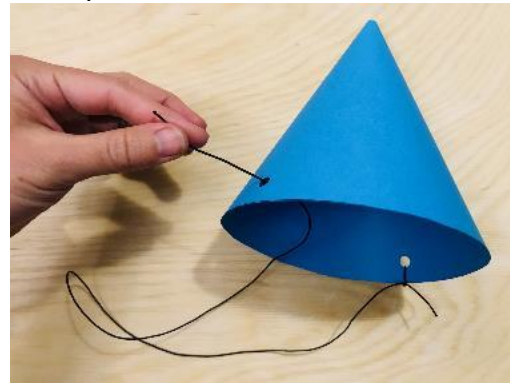
- 1) Cut out the template.



- 2) Fold the paper to form a cone shape by overlapping the two bottom edges to the marked dotted line and tape to secure.



- 3) Make two holes just above the base line on both sides of the hat. Thread the elastic through the holes and measure the length to fit your head then tie knots.



- 4) How are you going to design your party hat?
A selection of stickers and shapes can be found in the brown envelope for you to decorate your hat. Draw your additional decorations on plain white card, cut out and tape onto your hat.

- 3) Paper straws

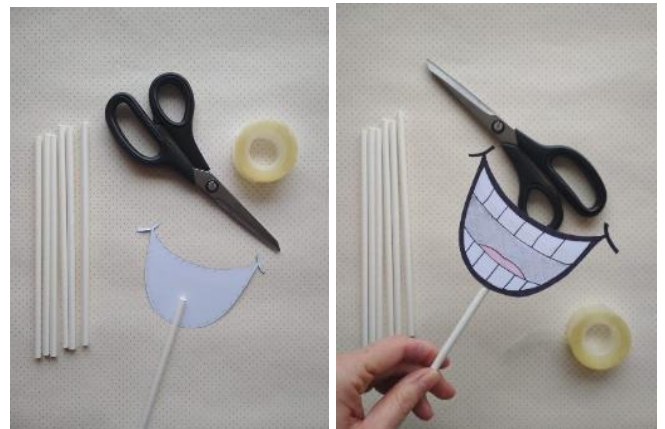
From home

Instructions

- 2) Fold in half, cut the unfolded side into strips stopping about a hand length from the folded middle all the way along.



- 3) Roll up tightly holding the uncut section.



- 4) Stick with the sticky labels to hold in place,
