

Activity: In the Picture

Open your pack and you should find:

A4 drawing of Jimmy Robert

Coloured A4 paper

1 x HB pencil

3 x coloured pencils

2 x coloured cellophane

1 x tracing paper

Mirrored sheet

Glue stick

You will need: Scissors



1. Set out your materials around you.


2. On the back of the Jimmy Robert sheet - use a pencil to draw you or someone in your family in a pose.




3. Colour or add patterns to one figure using your HB pencil.




4. Use the coloured crayons to colour or add patterns to the other figure.




5. Now pinch your sheet to make a small fold and carefully cut into it.




6. Fold over the cut section to make a triangular flap and triangular hole



7. You should be able to see part of your coloured image on your grey side, or part of your grey image on your coloured side.



8. Try the different coloured paper behind your chosen side. Choose your favourite background colour.




9. Cut triangles out of your coloured cellophane and tracing paper to add to your picture

You can add as many as you like,
anywhere you like!

Arrange them first then glue them down.

10. Use the mirrored sheet to look at your picture in different angles and hide and reveal different part of the picture.



11. Take a photo of the image and its reflection, this is your finished artwork!
