
Dress Grace: Instructions



1.Cut around the figure of Grace carefully.


The template is card so you may need some help.

Be careful not to cut between her feet, this helps support her to stand.



2.Cut out the long rectangle.

This will be used to add strength to Grace and help her stand up.



3.Use a ruler and a pencil if you have them, to score along the dotted line.

This will help you fold the rectangle strip in half. Carefully fold this in half as near to the line as you can.



4.Glue along one half of the rectangular strip, or you can use tape if you don't have glue.



5.Fold the tab at the feet of Grace backwards and then stick your rectangular strip to the back of Grace.

You can do the same for the microphone stand.



6.You now have a Grace figure that will stand up and is ready to dress!

You might want to put blue tack or tape on the base to help her stand up and in position.





7.Try creating a set for Grace using a cardboard box as the staging area.

8.Collect paper and card to help make your set. Wallpaper, wrapping paper, coloured paper, cardboard boxes or draw and paint your own!

9.Decide which costume you would like Grace to wear. You can add lots of colour to the costumes. There are plain sheets of paper for you to design your own!





- Try out different backgrounds.
- What extra objects do you need to set the scene?
- What is Grace doing in your stage set?
- This could be anything, singing, dancing, hula-hooping, roller-skating, a photo shoot, a fashion show, a disco, backstage, at home, or even walking the dog!
